Your skin is the largest organ of your body, so a skin cancer screening can also reveal much about your overall health and well-being.

Dermatologists are trained to catch the early signs and symptoms of skin cancer; precancers, basal cell cancers, squamous cell cancers and malignant melanoma. A good way to ensure early detection of these concerns is with an annual full body skin cancer screening examination.

What to Expect

During your skin cancer screening exam, a Trillium Creek provider will check every part of your body — including your head, nose, ears, breast, groin, buttocks, and toes. They will be looking for discolored areas, bumps, unusually shaped freckles, and spots with irregular borders. Full body exams are especially important for people who work outdoors.

Most skin conditions, if caught early, are 100% curable. If an area or bump looks suspicious, it will be biopsied through a simple procedure of numbing it and then shaving off a portion to send to a laboratory. Patients with a biopsy of proven skin cancers on the head and neck are referred to Dr. Patrick Killian at the Mohs Skin Cancer Center at Trillium Creek Dermatology.

The entire skin cancer screening procedure takes only 15 minutes — and that 15 minutes may save your life.



WHAT TO EXPECT DURING MOHS SURGERY?



The visible tumor and a small segment of surrounding skin are removed.



The tissue is examined under a microscope to see if any cancer cells remain at any of the edges.



If any cancer remains, additional skin continues to be removed and examined under the microscope.



This process continues until no more cancer cells are found.

There are different types of psoriasis. Most people have a type called plaque (pronounced plack) psoriasis. It's possible to have more than one type of psoriasis. What you see on your skin varies with the type of psoriasis you have and where it appears on your body. The following pictures will give you an idea of what the different types of psoriasis can look like.



Plaque (plack) psoriasis Patches of thick raised skin covered

with silvery scale form. These patches usually appear on the scalp, elbows, knees, or lower back — but they can develop anywhere on the skin.



Scalp psoriasis On the scalp, the psoriasis may be thin or thick. Very

thick patches can lead to hair loss. Whether thick or thin, the patches can extend beyond the scalp to the forehead, neck, or ears.



Nail psoriasis
This can
develop with
any type of
psoriasis.
Signs include

yellow-brown spots on the nails, pitted nails, crumbling nails, and nails separating from fingers or toes.



Guttate (gut-tate) psoriasis This type often

develops in children, who get it after they've had an infection, such as strep throat. Guttate psoriasis tends to cause lots of small, scaly spots.



Inverse psoriasis Found where skin touches skin, such as the armpit or

groin area, this type causes shiny, smooth patches instead of scaly ones. This psoriasis is often bright red and the skin may be sore.





On their hands and feet, people develop painful pus-

filled blisters and thick, scaly skin that cracks easily.



Generalized pustular psoriasis Rare and very serious, this type

of psoriasis requires emergency medical care. It begins with dry, red, and tender skin. Within hours, widespread pus-filled blisters appear.



Erythrodermic (eh-rith-rowder-mic) psoriasis This type of psoriasis causes large

areas of skin to look burnt. Anyone who has skin that looks burnt should see a doctor immediately because this type of psoriasis can be life threatening.

When it comes to conditioning, agility, strength and discipline, it doesn't get much better than wrestling. However, this highcontact sport can also pose a lot of potential problems for the skin. I have personally wrestled from a young age and wrestled in college at Ohio University.

With the wrestling season upon us, there are a number of relatively simple measures you can take during this season to significantly reduce the risk of skin infections.

Skin infections occur when the skin has been compromised in some way and microbes (such as bacteria, viruses, and fungi) make their way in. As you can imagine, a contact sport like wrestling provides plenty of opportunities for breaks boils on the skin. in the skin. In a hot and humid environment where microbes can thrive, you have the perfect recipe for required with severe a skin infection.

Impetigo/MRSA

Impetigo is a common bacterial infection often caused by the staph bacteria. It often can be seen on the face and upper body as a yellow crusted lesion. These are commonly treated with oral or topical antibiotics as they are highly contagious.

MRSA is another type of staph infection that is notoriously resistant to several antibiotics. It is highly contagious and dangerous. MRSA produces large painful Antibiotic pills are often necessary, and IV antibiotics may be infections.

Ringworm

Ringworm is a fungal infection that presents as a red and scaly rash that forms a circle on the skin, hence the name. It's very contagious and can occur on any part of the body. Ringworm can be treated with topical antifungal creams or oral antifungal pills.

Viral Infections

Herpes simplex type 1 is a highly contagious viral infection which can be easily transmitted from skin-to-skin contact. It typically appears as fluidfilled blisters on the skin and can enter the body through any break in the skin. Once infected, the herpes virus will become chronic and typically requires an oral antiviral treatment.

While it's true that the infections mentioned earlier are easily transmitted, there are a lot of simple and easy things wrestlers can do to protect themselves:

- 1. Shower immediately after a workout
- 2. Wear clean work-out gear every day
- 3. Remember to wash your knee pad regularly
- 4. Wipe down your head gear regularly with an antibiotic soap or with small amount of alcohol on a cotton ball.
- 5. Make sure the wrestling mats are being properly cleaned daily during the wrestling season.
- 6. If you think you are getting a skin infection, call our office immediately. We have wrestling forms in office and can get you the proper treatment so you can get back on the mat ASAP.

Understanding the five part positives of Accutane

You may have heard this treatment option for acne from either a dermatologist, a parent of one of your child's friends, or on the Internet. You have heard positive things about Accutane, and you have heard things that could cause some concern, but when you're informed properly, you can make the best decision about this treatment option for either your child's complexion, or yourself.

Accutane is a high dose of vitamin A that works on the oil glands. Treatment with Accutane is typically a 5-month course and is indicated for patients with moderate to severe acne, large cystic acne, acne that is scarring. Also, indicated for patients with

mild or moderate acne that have tried and failed previous treatments.

Accutane can be used by all types of individuals, with the only true contraindication being

pregnancy.

Many people voice concerns about placing themselves or their children on Accutane due to potential side effects of the medication. While it does have side effects, using Accutane is actually safer than using antibiotics long term and over 13 million patients worldwide have been treated with Accutane since the medication was approved in 1982. The main reason Accutane requires monthly appointments during treatment and is so closely monitored by the FDA is because it is considered to be pregnancy category X, meaning babies born to mothers currently using Accutane will have severe birth defects. For this reason, all patients require registration with the iPLEDGE system, females require two forms of birth control when on the drug, and monthly pregnancy tests while on the medication. There is no risk to future pregnancies once the medication is discontinued.

So what can you expect during your course of Accutane

treatment? About one out of five patients see a slight flare in

the acne during the first month of treatment due to the oil glands closing and pushing things out. Improvement is typically seen by month 2, with a

more dramatic skin clearance by month 3. Typically, between month 4-5, breakouts have stopped and new lesions rarely develop. The medication is stopped once there has been a complete clearance of the skin.

The most common side effects experienced during the course treatment are dryness: including dry lips, dry nose and nose bleeds, and dry itchy skin – which essentially means the medication is working because oil glands are being dried everywhere. Other less common side effects include irritation of the eye/eyelids, joint or muscle aches, temporary hair thinning, rash, intestinal symptoms, sun sensitivity, and irritability.

It is recommended to moisturize frequently while on the medication. Any products placed on the skin should be gentle and non-fragrant to minimize any further irritation. It is recommended to use plain Vaseline for dry or cracked lips, nasal saline or Vaseline for a dry nose.
